Lower Proficiency & Summer Semester

Requiring only a 45 TOEFL/ 4.5 IELTS to start the program, you can start in the Fall, Spring, or Summer to get to your degree faster. High performing students may be eligible to take additional credits. Complete the Pathway with at least 27 undergraduate or 10 graduate credits towards your major.

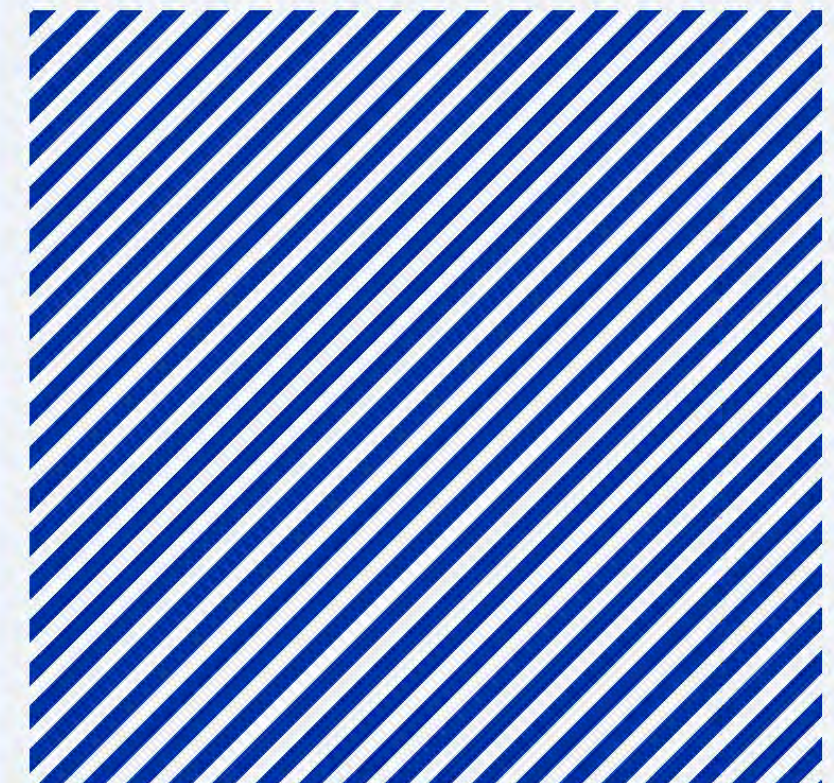

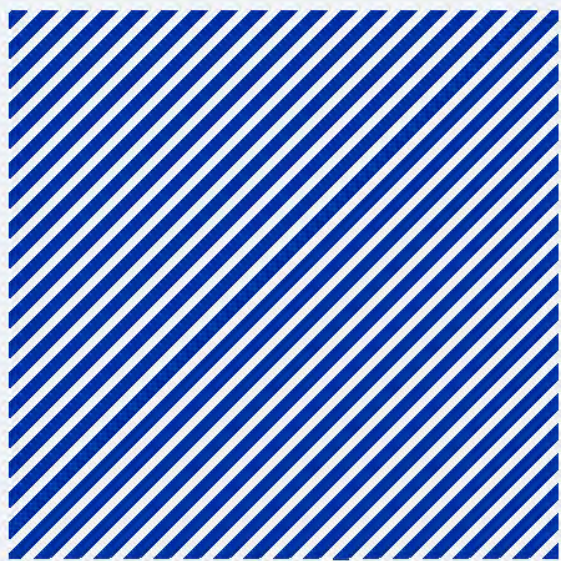

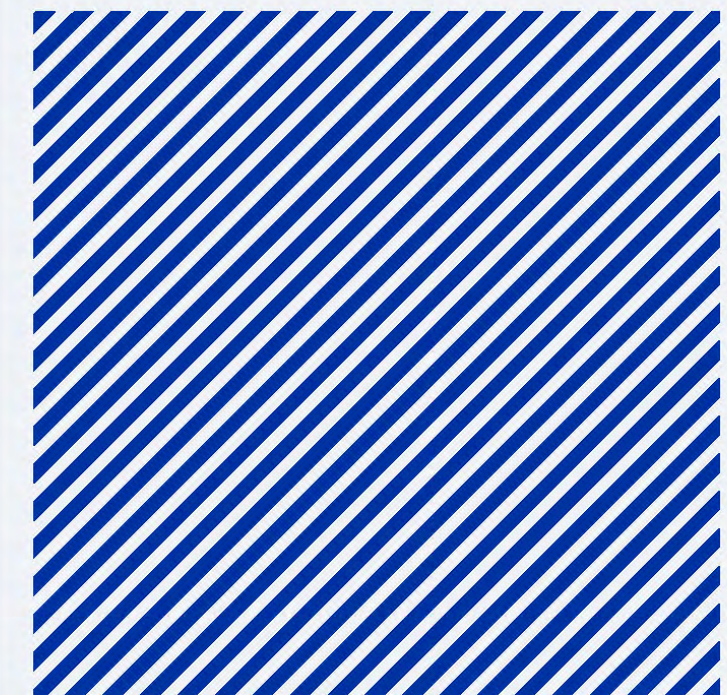

- You will have multiple opportunities for out of classroom experiences, including internships, research, volunteer, and professional job shadowing.

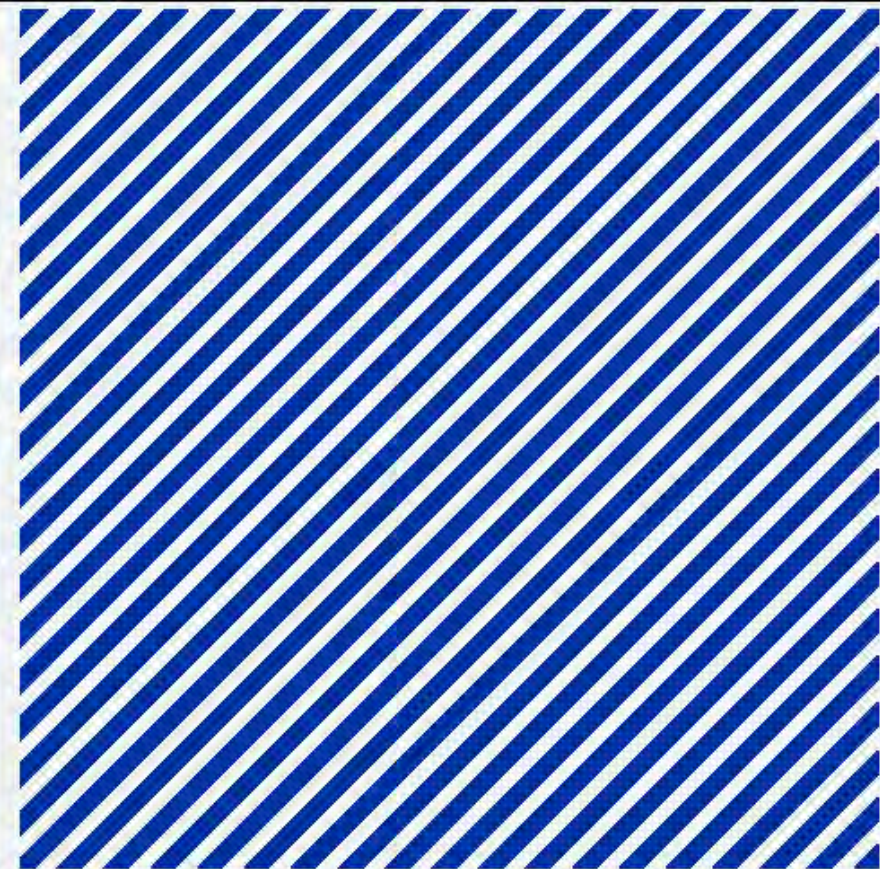

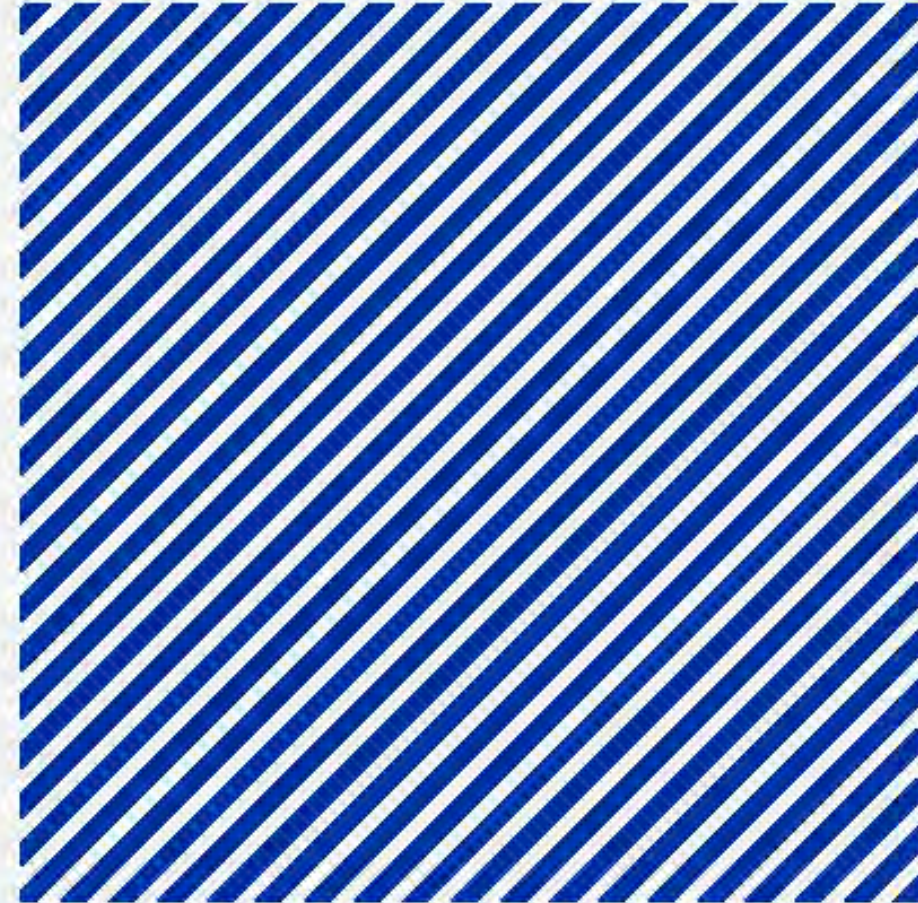

English Placement

■ TOEFL & IELTS

A TOEFL or IELTS is preferred. Please send your official score card to intlrecruit@fredonia.edu once you have completed your application.

■ TESTING ON ARRIVAL

All students will be tested during orientation. If the placement test is substantially different than the scores submitted for acceptance, the Pathway duration will be affected.

■ ONLINE PLACEMENT

An online placement test is available for students who do not have an official English score; however, some Visa officers may be less likely to approve a Visa without a TOEFL or IELTS score.

■ OTHER ENGLISH TESTS

If you have taken a different English proficiency exam, please contact intlrecr@fredonia.edu.

Changing/Shortening Pathways

■ **SHORTEN**

Revised English Proficiency scores are accepted up until the first day of orientation, after which no adjustments will be made to pathway placement using external test scores.

■ **MORE ENGLISH**

All students taking less than 20 hours of English per week are able to opt-in to additional paid English courses if they want more support.

■ **MORE CREDITS**

High performing students may be permitted to take additional credits during their pathway.

■ **DIRECT**

If a student receives a TOEFL or IELTS score that meets full-admissions (79/6.5) before the end of their pathway, they may transfer to their degree program.
