## Policy on Student Choice for Completion of General Education at The State University of New York at Fredonia Effective Fall 2010

All students who entered Fredonia in Fall 2010 or before are required to complete the 36 credit hour requirements for Categories 1-10 which include the successful completion of 2 courses from different disciplines in the Natural Sciences category and 2 courses from different disciplines in the Social Sciences category: <u>plus</u> the campus-specific local requirements for Categories 11 and 12.

Students who encounter difficulties in the pursuit of their timely degree attainment should consult their program Advisors or the General Education Office on an individual basis.

All students who enter Fredonia in Fall 2011 or later are required to complete all components of the Fredonia General Education Program, including all campus-specific local requirements beyond the minimum SUNY GER 30 credit hours.

All students entering Fredonia in Fall 2011 with a completed 30 credit hours in GenEd are deemed to have completed 30 credit hours of GenEd at Fredonia, and are required to complete only the campus-specific local requirements beyond the minimum SUNY GER 30 credit hours.
